The subject of this sketch, Dr. William Tazwell Upshaw, son of Lewis G. and Alice Thornton Upshaw, was born March 29th, 1829, near Elkton, Giles County, Tennessee, and died of pneumonia, January 31st, 1878, at his residence near LaGrange, Lee County, Arkansas, aged 48 years, 10 months And 2 days.

From his parents, who were wealthy, he received a liberal literary and medical education. He graduated at the celebrated Jefferson Medical College of Philadelphia, in 1854, and was the pupil and *protégé* of the distinguished Doctor Mutter of that city.

After graduating at Philadelphia he practiced medicine for some years in north Alabama; moved to Memphis in 1860 and served as a surgeon in the Confederate Hospital of that city till its occupation by the Federal forces. He afterwards joined the 14th Alabama cavalry, in which he served till discharged on account of ill health. He then attended a course in the medical and surgical school in New Orleans. In 1862, May 29th, he was married to Miss Josephine Le Barm, daughter of Dr. Rayburn, of New Orleans.

After the war he located on Horn Lake, in Mississippi. In 1870 he removed to Lee County, Ark., where he continued to reside and practice his profession till his death.

The writer of this sketch was well acquainted with Dr. Upshaw for several years, and knew him intimately as one medical man can know another ... (lengthy eulogy follows).
